Sardische Sprache, Literatur, Landeskunde, Note: 1,7, Universität des Saarlandes, Veranstaltung: Literaturwissenschaft Italienisch, Sprache: Deutsch, Abstract: In der italophilen Literaturforschung nimmt Carlo Goldoni eine zentrale Rolle ein, weil er als einer der wichtigsten Reformatoren des italienischen Theaters gilt. In dieser Arbeit sollen seine inhaltlichen und formalen Neuerungen, welche den Wandel von der epochentypischen Lachkomödie hin zu einer realitätsnahen Theaterdarstellung einleiteten, näher beleuchtet werden. Außerdem soll Goldonis Vision des neuen Theaters anhand prägender Charakteristika im Theaterstück "La Bottega del Caffè" erläutert werden. Hierbei werden wir zum einen den moralischen Gehalt seiner Werke erfahren, zum anderen einen Überblick zur damaligen Theatersituation erhalten. Weiterhin wird Eugenio, der Jüngling, um dem sich die Handlung dreht, im Laufe des Theaterstücks eine Wandlung durchlaufen, die Goldonis Wertemaßstäbe widerspiegelt. Dieser Neubeginn soll unter Berücksichtigung des zeithistorischen Kontexts analysiert werden. Goldoni ist es gelungen, den Alltag der venezianischen Gesellschaft hinsichtlich seiner moralischen Vergehen und seiner Tugendhaftigkeit einzurahmen und in verschiedenen Theaterstücken einem Publikum vorzulegen. Aus seinen Schriften sticht besonders seine ethische und moralische Haltung heraus, die Analogien zum Denken des Aufklärungszeitalters aufweist und den stattfindenden Paradigmenwechsel hin zu einer dogmenfreien und vernunftgeleiteten Perspektive des Menschen nachvollziehbar erscheinen lässt.

"Mondo e teatro sono i due libri sui quali ho più meditato e di cui non mi pentirò mai di essermi servito". Con questa frase Carlo Goldoni riassume tutta la sua attività di letterato e di uomo di scena, intendendo come mondo l'esperienza diretta della società a lui contemporanea e per teatro la pratica diretta della realtà del palcoscenico. La sua poetica difatti ribadisce la necessità di dare verosimiglianza a personaggi ed ambienti creando una nuova commedia italiana che, a differenza di quella francese, vede realizzarsi sulla scena il disegno di più caratteri e non di uno solo predominante. La bottega del Caffè, scritta nel 1750, narra le vicende dei personaggi che frequentano il caffè gestito da Ridolfo. Vittima del maldicente Don Marzio è Eugenio, un giovane mercante che ha perso enormi somme alla bisca.
