Kūkai was born into an aristocratic family and as a youth was trained in the Confucian Classics. In 791, at the age of 17, he is said to have completed his first major work, the Sangō shiki (“Essentials of the Three Teachings”), in which he proclaimed the superiority of Buddhism over Confucianism and Taoism.

Kūkai, also known posthumously as Kōbō-Daishi, 27 July 774 – 22 April 835, was a Japanese Buddhist monk, civil servant, scholar, poet, and artist who founded the Esoteric Shingon or "mantra" school of Buddhism. Shingon followers usually refer to him by the honorific title of Odaishisama and the religious name of Henjō-Kongō. Kūkai is famous as a calligrapher and engineer. In legend he is attributed with the invention of the kana syllabary, with which the Japanese language is written ...

After completing a major work, The Treatise on The Ten Stages of the Development of Mind in 830, Kukai became ill in 831. He left around fifty works on esoteric Shingon doctrine. He's also said to have developed the combined kanji and kana writing system used today. At the end of 832, Kukai returned to Mt. Koya.
