## **Dating Knossos and the arrival of the earliest Neolithic ...**

Bronze Age remains of Knossos in the early 1900s (Mackenzie 1903), more Neolithic remains were excavated in the following decades by the same team (Evans 1928). Evans saw the development of the Neolithic as a continuum with the Early Minoan layers. Subsequently, Furness (1953) studied and published the Neolithic pottery from Evans' test soundings.

## **Dating Knossos and the arrival of the earliest Neolithic ...**

Knossos was inhabited for several thousand years, beginning with a neolithic settlement sometime in the seventh millennium BC, and was abandoned after its destruction in 1375 BC which marked the end of Minoan civilization. The first palace on the low hill beside the Krairatos river was built around 1900 BC on the ruins of previous settlements.

Knossos is thought to be the first settlement in the Neolithic period, though it is in fact, one of many Neolithic remains scattered across Crete. The site of Knossos is multilayered, revealing inhabitation for many, many years.
